

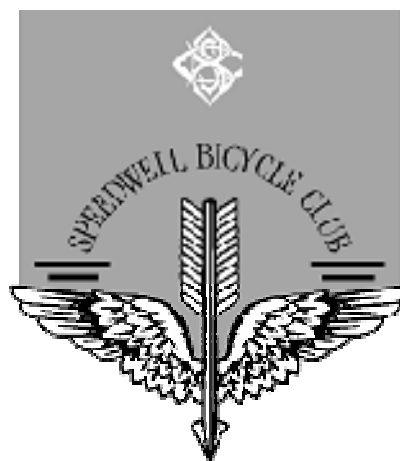

### **There's Life in the Old Dog Yet...**

It was always a great regret of my "first cycling career" – the one that lasted from 1973 to 1986 – that I didn't break the hour for '25' miles or 23 minutes for a '10'. So it was with some trepidation that at the tender age of 47 and for the first time in a cycling career of over 35 years, I decided to get a coach and see if it was possible. I bought one of those heart rate thingies, subjected myself to a torture known as a "ramp test" and attempted to add a little science to the art of training. That was 2 years ago now. Funny bikes and hats followed.



The result has been a structured training programme of steady, hard rides with a repertoire of excruciating interval sessions. However, off just 7 hours a week training it seems to have paid off with some of the

best form I've ever enjoyed. All rather alarming really and I wish I'd found out all this a bit earlier.

I rode the track in 2005 at Halesowen and was just making up the numbers, but in 2006 and 7 have found myself getting "up there". The short sprints are hopeless but the longer events – 2 miles up to 10 have been better. A couple of wins, when things have gone in my favour, have been particularly rewarding. Beating and being beaten by guys a third your age is interesting!

By the end of 2006, I'd managed to get inside 23 minutes for a 10 and had a 1:1 for a '25'.

2007 began OK, 22:46 in late April in Vets National 10 (good for 24th!). Then work got very heavy meaning 3 weeks with virtually no riding in June and July. No track with the bad weather, wet training rides. "Is this worth it?"



Then I got "that float afternoon", you know, the one you dream about – a balmy September Saturday, Indian summer, 22°C and not a breath of air on a fast course down in Andover. I knew I'd started fast (although the downhill start helped). I reached the turn at 5 miles in 10:21. "Goodness, might get inside 22 here". Return leg got a bit "grippy" and there were a couple of drags with the now head wind rising a little. Caught by my minute man with 500m to go. "No disgrace there though he's got a pb of 19 something". I give it my best flat out "track finish", red mist and everything. Clicked my watch - 21:45. "Hell's teeth, that's a club record".

The following day I rode the '25', clocking 57:45. So, broken the hour at last. What next? Thought I might give the National Vets Track Champs a go. When you're 50 the distances drop!

## **Secretary's Report, 2006-7**

### **Social Events**

The regular informal club rides held on Sunday mornings throughout the year were attended by at least three members – Ed Matthews, Steve Lockwood and Jeff Matthews. The published runs list continues to act as a focus for this activity.

A club tour was held in August, attended by three members and two guests. Andy Seabourne continues to provide excellent service, with a well organised 4 days round Dorset.

A number of members continue to support the CTC Section based on Wythall.

### **Racing**

Jeff Matthews has continued to race during 2006 and 7. The strange rush of blood to the head has resulted in placing second in the Vets section of the track league at Halesowen, 3rd in B Cats overall and actually winning a number of events. He has also been seen riding Madison races and the Newport wooden indoor track.

More startlingly, Jeff broke the club 10-mile record in September of this year, recording an all time personal best of 21:51, taking over 30 seconds off the previous record set by Phil O'Hara in 1973 and nearly a minute off his PB. He then went on to record 57:45, just 18 seconds off the 25-mile record, the following day.

### **Open Event: Mountain 36**

The club promoted the Mountain 36 Time Trial, which attracted only 25 riders this year. This is a serious drop in numbers. We are reviewing this event and although promoting it in 2008 will take a decision if it can be sustained. A number of riders have said they are prepared to join in efforts to increase awareness and promotion of the event. The event itself was won by Daniel Soltys in 1:33:06, a course and event record. The club was represented by Jeff Matthews who got round in 1:56:04.

### **Membership**

Membership stands at 33 no change over 2005.

### **Committee Meetings**

None were held again during the year. This has become the pattern of recent years and seems to work. The Secretary would be pleased to hear from any members with other views. With our current level of activity there seems little reason to change this, unless there is a view otherwise.

### **Forthcoming Events**

Following our success of a few years ago, the club has been asked to promote the GHS 10 mile National Time Trial Championships for school age riders up to 16 years of age. This will be in September 2009.

The 2008 Mountain 36 is scheduled for May 18th. It will be based on Cleobury Mortimer as in previous years. Your support will be very welcome.
